MOTION TO SET AMOUNT OF ASSIGNEE'S BOND

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, all creditors and interested parties have **20 days** from the date of service of this motion to object to the Assignee's employment of Stichter, Riedel, Blain & Prosser, P.A. as counsel to the Assignee in this assignment proceeding. You must file your objection to this Motion with Clerk of the Hillsborough County Circuit Court, Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, George E. Edgecomb Courthouse, 800 Twiggs Street, Tampa, Florida, 33602 and serve a copy on Susan Heath Sharp, Esquire, Stichter Riedel Blain & Prosser, 110 E. Madison Street, Suite 200, Tampa, Florida 33602. If you file and serve an objection within the time permitted, the Court will schedule a hearing and you will be notified.

LARRY S. HYMAN, CPA ("Assignee"), by and through his undersigned attorney, hereby files this Motion to Set Amount of Assignee's Bond and in support of the Motion, says:

1. On April 12, 2010, Assignee filed a Petition initiating this Assignment for the Benefit of Creditors pursuant to Florida Statute §727.104(2)(b).

1. Pursuant to Florida Statute §727.104, Assignee is required to obtain a bond made payable to the Clerk of the Court in an amount no less than two times the liquidation value of the assets listed on Schedule "B".

2. Schedule "B" of the Assignment reflects that there are assets consisting of cash, causes of action, claims, accounts receivables, furniture, fixtures and equipment. The exact value is unknown; the Assignee estimates that the liquidation value is no more than \$75,862.50. The amount of unsecured debt is well in excess of these amounts. In addition, secured debt is in excess of \$857,000.

3. Accordingly, Assignee seeks authority to obtain a bond in the amount of \$10,000.


4. The bond can be modified if the asset value is determined to be more than the estimate by the Assignee.

5. A reduced bond and corresponding reduced premium, especially when the total liquidation value of the assets has not been determined, is reasonable. The current request allows the premium payment to be reasonable and conserves value for the creditors since premium payments are paid from the estate.

WHEREFORE, the Assignee respectfully requests that the Court grant this

Motion, authorize the Bond in the amount of \$10,000, and grant such other and further relief as is just.


