**ORDER ON MOTION TO AMEND ORDER ON MOTION OF KEY WEST HEALTH
AND REHABILITATION CENTER, LLC FOR ENTRY OF AN ORDER (I) APPROVING
BID PROCEDURES IN CONNECTION WITH THE SALE OF SUBSTANTIALLY
ALL OF ITS ASSETS, (II) ESTABLISHING PROCEDURES FOR THE
ASSUMPTION AND/OR ASSIGNMENT BY THE DEBTOR OF CERTAIN EXECUTORY
CONTRACTS AND UNEXPIRED LEASES, (III) APPROVING BREAK UP FEE
AND MINIMUM OVERBID AMOUNT, (IV) APPROVING FORM AND MANNER OF
NOTICE OF BIDDING PROCEDURES, AND (V) SETTING OBJECTION DEADLINES**

THIS CASE came on for consideration upon the Motion to Amend Order on Motion of Key West Health and Rehabilitation Center, LLC for Entry of an Order (I) Approving Bid Procedures in Connection with the Sale of Substantially All of Its Assets, (II) Establishing

Procedures for the Assumption and/or Assignment by the Debtor of Certain Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases, (III) Approving Break Up Fee and Minimum Overbid Amount, (IV) Approving Form and Manner of Notice of Bid Procedures, and (V) Setting Objection Deadlines [Doc. No. 1149] (the “**Motion**”). The Motion seeks to amend certain dates in the Bid Procedures Order.¹ The Motion reflects that the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors supports the relief requested in the Motion. The Court having considered the above, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The deadline to serve the Assumption and Assignment Notice shall be extended until April 10, 2010.
3. The Cure Amount Objection Deadline shall be extended to May 4, 2010.
4. The Regal Assumption Objection Deadline shall be extended to May 4, 2020.
